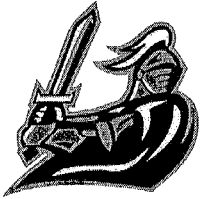

- SIP Goals (Updates)
 - Goal 1 If we communicate clear, consistent expectations in a positive manner, then discipline, attendance, and morale will improve
 - *Students attending school less than 90% of the time will decrease from % to %
 - *Discipline will drop from 1080 incidents by 25% to 810.
 - **As of 11/17 we are on track to achieving this goal with only 123 incidents.**
