Principal's Report:

King Middle School raised its grade from a C to a B. The total points earned in all tested areas increased 55 points (431 to 486). A committee of comprised of teachers will be selected to propose a plan for the funds that will be awarded to the school because of the grade increase. The plan must be approved by SAC, and submitted by February 1, 2018.

In a review of the 2017-2018 School Improvement Plan (SIP), Mrs. Romeo explained the school's focus. It was the consensus of the teachers that a concentrated focus on Reading would best most beneficial to students. Methods will include coaching students on strategies to increase their reading stamina and strategies to organize their writing.
