Activities that we look forward to getting back on the schedule: In person Title 1 meeting, Donuts with Dads, Hispanic History Night Celebration, Black History Month Celebration (currently scheduled for in-person event), Fine Arts Showcase, ESOL Parent Meetings (2), Staff trainings (Book Studies, SEL, Child Trafficking, ESE).
