**New Business: Principals report:** A/C will be finished hopefully by Jan, There is a proposal to upgrade other items with excess funds. Curricula guide went out last week and staff is looking at the next year. Open house on Jan. 11<sup>th</sup>, they cannot advertise however it is a great event for new parents. Choice period will be the same time. Exam schedule is released – only change is that they will run school on the bell schedule, 7:30 arrival move to brunch then study hall period followed by exams. Parents can choose to drop off their student at normal time or at the exam time. They will not be issuing tardies for those who do not come at 7:30. MHS received funds for moving from C school to a B school, teachers are meeting to put in requests we will have the requests next month. We do have some students that will have their school choice revoked, however not many. Administration is working with the city to look at safer routes for our students to get to school such as sidewalks, a stop light at cross walk etc. Requesting that the first public meeting be held at MHS. Our track will be upgraded to a rubberized track sometime in the next 3 months. ESOL evening next week, Boot Camp for students getting ready for P.E.R.T coming up.
