# WHAT IS A SCHOOL ADVISORY COUNCIL?

- ▶ The School Advisory Council(SAC)is a school-based group intended to represent the school, the community, and those persons closest to the students that shares responsibility for supporting the school's continuous improvement.

# WHO SERVES ON THE SAC?

- ▶ A SAC should be composed of the principal and an appropriately balanced number of:
  - ▶ teachers, education support employees, students, parents, and other business and community citizens who are representative of the ethnic, racial, and economic community served by the school. Only students in secondary schools serve on a SAC.
  - ▶ It is also a requirement that the majority of the members of the SAC are not employed by the school district.

# WHAT IS THE ROLE OF THE SAC?

- ▶ The SAC is responsible for final decision-making at the school relating to the annual implementation of a schoolwide improvement plan (SIP). The SAC assists in the annual preparation of both the SIP and the school's annual budget, as well as the evaluation of the SIP.
