A+ Recognition Money Approval/Vote	Mrs. West shared that this is the second time our school is receiving this incentive. Our school went from a D to a C and this is part of the incentive. The school will be receiving around \$7,800.00. All staff member (97 people voted) and Option 1 was the choice of disbursement. This option means that <i>bonuses will be distributed equally, and all staff employed last year and still current employee at Bayshore would be entitled to bonuses, including contracted employees such as OT, PT, and speech. Last year's employee who left Bayshore would not be entitled to any bonuses. Off campus School Board employee, employed last year and this year at Bayshore would also be entitled to bonuses at a prorated amount based on the amount of time they are at Bayshore.</i> SAC members will vote and approve the fund. Mrs. West made a motion to move and accept the vote. The committee voted. All in attendance approved and passed the vote.
