Dual Enrollment (part-time) up to 11 credit hours	3.0 unweighted GPA College level test scores math and/or reading and English.
Early Admissions (full-time) 12-15 credit hours for <i>seniors only</i>	3.0 unweighted GPA College level test scores math and/or reading and English.
Accelerated Dual Enrollment (ADE) (full-time) up to 15 credit hours junior/senior only for Sarasota & Manatee counties public school students. <i>*verification of eligibility is confirmed by the district in the summer.</i>	3.3 unweighted GPA College level test scores in <u>all</u> areas Be academically ready for the 11 th grade to include: -English I -English II -Algebra I and passed Algebra I end-of course (EOC) or a comparative score on the Postsecondary Education Readiness Test (state assessment requirement) -Geometry with passed EOC -Passed Grade 10 ELA state assessment or ACT/SAT with concordant score

DEADLINES: Fall semester- May 15th Spring semester- December 1st

Requirements of Early College Programs

- **Dual Enrollment Application:** Available online at www.scf.edu. Once the application is processed, the student will receive a “Welcome” email with information on how to get credentials.
- **Qualifying Test Scores:** Testing is available through www.scf.edu/testing. Student may qualify with SAT, ACT or PERT scores.
- **Dual Enrollment Contract:** Students must gain approval from their high school counselor/official for the type of dual enrollment and intended career path (General, Business or STEM focus). This approval must be verified by the student, parent/guardian, and high school counselor/official. A new contract is only needed if the intended type of dual enrollment or career path changes for a future semester. The contract can be found on the Early College website (www.scf.edu/earlycollege).
- **Online Orientation:** Links to complete the online orientation will be in the initial “Welcome” email. ADE students will have an additional intake video/quiz plus a mandatory advising appointment.
- **Homeschool Students:** Must submit Sarasota or Manatee County School Approval for Homeschool Education county letter each year.
- **Course Registration:** Once an application, test scores and contract are in place the student may register for SCF classes by the published deadline.

Qualifying Test Scores

- **ACT/SAT/PERT scores** can be used to qualify for Early College Programs. Test scores are valid for two consecutive years beginning from the date the test was administered. *PERT testing may be taken only once per semester and twice per calendar year.*
- **ACT/SAT scores** must be sent to State College of Florida, Office of the Registrar. Students must request scores online. SAT code: 5427 ACT code: 0741

- **PERT scores** can be submitted to registrar@scf.edu by the high school counselor/official, or a student may register online by visiting www.scf.edu/testing. Students must present a photo ID to test.

AP/CLEP/IB/AICE scores

- Student must submit official scores/transcripts to the Office of the Registrar.
- Scores are not used as qualifiers for entrance into Early College Programs.

Registration

- Students may register for 16-week full term classes only.
- Students are responsible for their own registration each semester via MYSCF.
- A dual enrollment contract must on file with SCF.
- Students should be familiar with the SCF academic calendar.
- Students must register by the published deadline.
- Student must provide detailed schedule to their high school counselor.

Textbooks (Required Materials only)

Public School Students: Students should connect with their high school counselor for the textbook procedure.

Homeschool & Private Students: Students are responsible for purchasing their own materials.

Parking Decal & Student ID

The Office of Public Safety will issue a free parking decal and student ID to every student. Students must bring a government issued photo ID to obtain an SCF ID. Students should be prepared to provide their G#.

Academic Expectations

Early College Programs are an opportunity to take challenging courses and are accelerated educational opportunities. The amount of work necessary to succeed in college level courses may be much greater than in high school courses. Professors will provide students will a syllabus that outlines the expectations for the semester. Dual enrollment courses become a part of a student’s permanent college transcript and may impact eligibility for Admissions and Financial Aid to other postsecondary institutions.

- Students are expected to abide by the SCF student handbook and review the SCF academic calendar.
- Students must maintain a 3.0 high school unweighted GPA.
- Students must earn a “C” or better in all classes.
